Partnership with Edmonton Catholic Schools and Concordia University

ECSD has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Concordia University to provide specialized supports to schools in meeting the demands of students' mental health.

To honour the official signing, the Board of Trustees welcomed special guests and members of Concordia's administration including Dr. Maureen Stratton, Dean of the Faculty of Education, Dr. Wendy Pullin, Professor of Psychology, Director, Psychology Graduate Programs Faculty of Arts, Dr. Farzad Zare-Bawani, Associate Professor of Psychology, Undergraduate Studies and Dr. Colin Neufeldt, Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

This MOU will help ECSD strive to further support mental health needs within our schools.
