


Arrival Time




You must show up for the exam on time! Especially if you are writing a Diploma Exam.

Diplomas start at 9:00am!


Arrive Early


A few other important details




Do not leave your desk during the exam. Raise your hand and the supervisor will come to you



You are permitted to use the washroom during the exam, but you will be escorted by a supervisor and only 1 student can be in the washroom at a time



Supervisors need to check over your exam and clear your calculator before you leave the exam room



Please be as quiet in the hallways as possible during the exams. Students will not be permitted to socialize in the hallways when exams are in session

Violation of exam rules can result in your exam being invalidated and you will be asked to leave
