Configure Mac OS X Devices for secure Wi-Fi access

The following instructions will allow you to connect your personal Mac OS X device to the ECSD-Priv wireless network.

Configuration instructions:

- 1. Click the Wi-Fi icon 📦 at the top right hand corner of the screen.
- You will then be presented with a list of available networks. From the list, select "ECSD-Priv". If you do not see a list of available networks, please check that the Wi-Fi is turned on.



3. You will be prompted to input a **username** and **password**. Please enter your ECSD username, e.g. "id18774", and your password.



- 4. Click "Join".
- If you are connecting for the first time, your computer has not yet accepted the certificate that encrypts the connection. It will show a Windows Security warning prompting to Verify Certificate
 - Please verify the certificate name is "wifiguest.ecsd.net" before accepting it.
 - Click **Continue** in order to trust the certificate and connect to the network.



6. After accepting the certificate, you will notice that ECSD-Priv shows **Connected.**

NOTE: Please note that these instructions were taken with a Mac OS X El Capitan – version 10.11.5

Your device should now connect automatically to the ECSD-Priv wireless network whenever it is in range.
