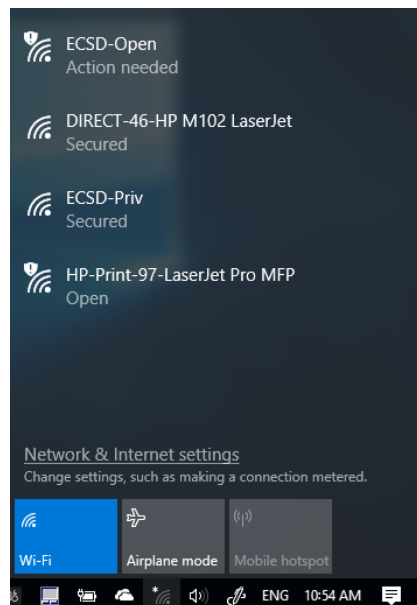


Configure Windows 10 Devices for secure Wi-Fi access

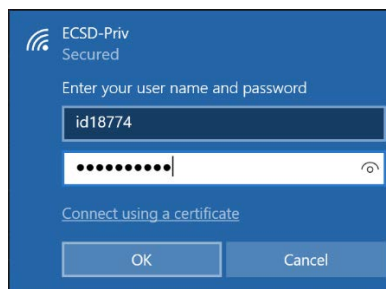
The following instructions will allow you to connect your personal Windows 10 device to the ECSD-Priv wireless network.

Configuration instructions:

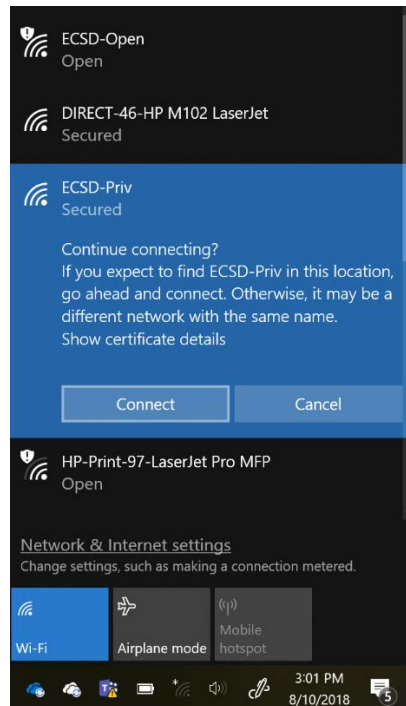
1. Click the Wi-Fi icon  at the bottom right hand corner of the screen.
2. You will then be presented with a list of available networks. From the list, click on "ECSD-Priv". If you do not see a list of available networks, please check that the Wi-Fi is turned on.



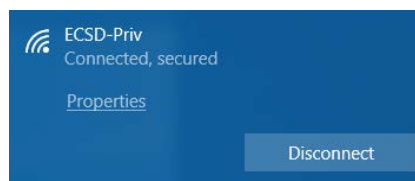
3. You will be prompted to input a **username** and **password**. Please enter your ECSD username, e.g. "id18774", and your password.



4. Click "**OK**".
5. If you are connecting for the first time, your computer has not yet accepted the certificate that encrypts the connection. It will show a Windows Security warning prompting to **Continue Connecting?**
6. Click **Connect** in order to trust the certificate and connect to the network.



7. You will notice that ECSD-Priv shows **Connected, secured**.



NOTE: Please note that you will have to "Forget" the ECSD-Priv wireless network in order to change the username or password.

Your device should now connect automatically to the ECSD-Priv wireless network whenever it is in range.
